

## **Chapter 19**

### **ELECTIONS**

**[HISTORY: Derived from Title 1, Ch. 4, Art. 2, of the 1993 Code of the Village of Port Byron. Amendments noted where applicable.]**

#### **§ 19-1. Election date.**<sup>1</sup>

In the best interests of the Village and pursuant to the provisions of Article 2a of the Election Code, 10 ILCS 5/2a-1 et seq., the Village of Port Byron hereby designates the date as set by the State of Illinois and Rock Island County.

#### **§ 19-2. Election precinct.**<sup>2</sup>

The territory embraced within the corporate limits of the Village shall be one election precinct, and no person shall vote at any election who has not resided in said Village, in the County of Rock Island, and in the State of Illinois 30 days previous to the time of offering his vote. An elector must be 18 years of age or older.
